

Disabled bullying

SIR - Your report (July 26) on the Home Secretary's call for parents and teachers to report homophobic and racist bullying does not mention the bullying endured by disabled people.

Our report, *Under Investigation*, found that two thirds of young disabled people had experienced taunting or verbal abuse due to their disability. We are calling on Amber Rudd to take tough measures to tackle disability hate crime in her plan. We would welcome the opportunity to help the Government shape new teaching materials by involving young people in their production.

This will help foster a culture where young people are raised to accept disabled people, while stamping out hate crime which still affects millions.
