

Wife to let man die in 'final act' of love

◆ A Gulf War veteran left severely brain damaged after a motorcycle crash will be taken off life support as his wife says letting him die is her "final act" of love.

Paul Briggs, 43, was hit by a dangerous driver while serving with Merseyside Police in July 2015.

Experts were split on his chances of recovery and his wife Lindsey, 40, had

to take legal action to have his life-sustaining treatment withdrawn.

In December, a judge decided Mr Briggs, a father-of-one, should be allowed to die and he is due to be transferred from hospital to a palliative care centre soon.

Mrs Briggs said: "It's so awful but this is the last thing I can do for the man I love."
