

# Challenge to assisted dying law granted

◆ A man with motor neurone disease has been given permission to challenge the law on assisted dying.

Retired college lecturer Noel Conway, 67, took his case to the Court of Appeal after being denied a judicial review over the ban on assisting a person to die.

Mr Conway, from Shrewsbury, said: "Having overcome this initial setback

in my fight for choice at the end of life, I am more determined than ever to continue."

He was diagnosed with the disease in November 2014 and is not expected to live beyond 12 months.

Lord Justice McFarlane and Lord Justice Beatson granted permission and the case will now go to the High Court.
