

## Boots cuts pill price after anti-abortion lobby row

Boots has announced plans to cut the price of its cheapest morning-after pill, six weeks after *The Times* revealed that it kept prices high to avoid a backlash from anti-abortion campaigners. A generic version of the drug, levonorgestrel, is now on sale at 38 shops for £15.99, compared with £26.75 previously. The drug will be distributed to all 2,500 branches from next month. Boots said the timescale was to allow the manufacturer to increase supply. Tesco and Superdrug offer the pill for £13.50.
