

Man loses latest bid to contest right-to-die law

A paralysed former builder has lost a High Court bid to challenge the law on assisted dying.

Paul Lamb, 63, from Leeds, previously lost a right-to-die case in the Supreme Court in 2014.

He argued the current law, which bans assisted suicide under threat of up to 14 years in jail, is discriminatory and breaches his human rights.

Ruling in London, two leading judges said previous cases on the issue had concluded that it was a matter for Parliament and not the courts.
